

## Judo BC Selection Criteria to host Judo BC Provincial Events 2017-2018

#### **Selection Process:**

The Technical Committee is responsible for selecting host clubs for training camps and youth and senior championships. The selections process takes into consideration the strength of the bids submitted as well as the following:

- Conflicting dates with Judo Canada events and other major tournaments;
- Conflicting dates with stat/school holidays, etc.;
- Available accommodations in local area.

Applicants will be sent an email by the Judo BC Office confirming receipt of their bids.

The Judo BC Office will notify <u>all</u> applicants of the final hosting assignments within 24 hours of the selection meeting.

#### 1. <u>Judo BC Winter Training camp – Preferred dates Dec 27 – 20, 2017</u>

- Mat space must be able to accommodate up to 100 athletes and coaches.
- ➤ A \$25 camp fee will be charged per athlete and will be payable to Judo BC. The camp host will receive 50% of net proceeds of the camp fees to assist with hosting costs related to the event.

#### 2. BC Youth Championships (winter or spring) – Preferred date February 10, 2018

Judo BC will rotate the location of the Youth Championships throughout the province. Clubs must bid to secure hosting rights each year.

- ➤ Host club must follow all Judo BC sanction rules and regulations.
- ➤ Host club must produce Technical Package in collaboration with Judo BC, for distribution to all clubs 3 months prior to the event.
- Youth Championships and the associated provincial practices are only open to Judo BC athletes.
- Registration to be done online with the support of Judo BC.
- Entries to be posted on the Judo BC website one week prior to the shiai
- Minimum 2 mat areas, 3 mat areas preferred.
- ➤ U21/U18/U16/U14 only, minimum rank orange belt
- U14 athletes may compete in U16 (minimum age is 12 years old).
- ➤ Host club to book host hotel, secure reasonable sport rate for athletes and their families, meeting rooms (2) for weigh-in (male/female).
- ➤ Weigh-in to be held at host hotel or at the competition venue the evening before the competition, unofficial scale must be available at least 1 hour before the start of the official weigh-in.
- Training camp on Sunday
- The \$60 entry fee includes tournament registration fee and provincial practice the next day.
- Shiai & training camp supported by Judo BC
  - o Judo BC to provide medals

- Judo BC Tournament Committee will offer support of JudoShiai software package and the organization of the tournament. Assistance with the CARE system will be available as well.
- o Judo BC Head Coach will oversee the delivery of training camp

#### 3. Senior Championships & Spring Camp (combined event) – Preferred dates April 28 & 29, 2018

Judo BC will rotate the location of the Senior Championships and Spring Camp throughout the province. Clubs must bid to secure hosting rights each year.

- ➤ Host club must follow all Judo BC sanction rules and regulations
- ➤ Host club must produce Technical Package in collaboration with Judo BC, for distribution to all clubs three months prior to the event
- > Senior Championships and the associated provincial practices are only open to Judo BC athletes.
- Registration to be done online with the support of Judo BC
- Entries to be posted on the Judo BC website one week prior to the shiai
- Minimum 2 mat areas
- ➤ Senior Championships open to all athletes U18, U21, Senior & Veterans, minimum rank blue belt. All competitors will fight in the senior age division. For example: senior women's -57kg may have U18, U21 and Veterans age athletes all fighting against each other.
- To be held in conjunction with the Spring Camp, which is open to all U16 and older athletes, minimum rank green belt. U14 Earlier Bloomers may be invited to the camp.
- ➤ Host club to book host hotel, secure reasonable sport rate for athletes and their families, meeting rooms (2) for weigh-in (male/female).
- ➤ Weigh-in to be held at host hotel or at the competition venue the evening before the competition, unofficial scale must be available at least 1 hour before the start of the official weigh-in.
- > Training camp on Friday, Saturday afternoon and Sunday
- ➤ The \$85 entry fee includes tournament and camp registration fees. \$25 for the training camp only.
- Shiai and training camp supported by Judo BC:
  - o Judo BC to provide medals
  - Judo BC Tournament Committee will offer support of JudoShiai software package and the organization of the tournament. Assistance with the CARE system will be available as well.
  - o Judo BC Head Coach will oversee the delivery of training camp

#### **Application deadline:**

Bids must be received by the Judo BC Office <u>no later than 4:30pm on July 31, 2017.</u> Incomplete or late bids will not be forward to the Technical & Competition Committee for review.
