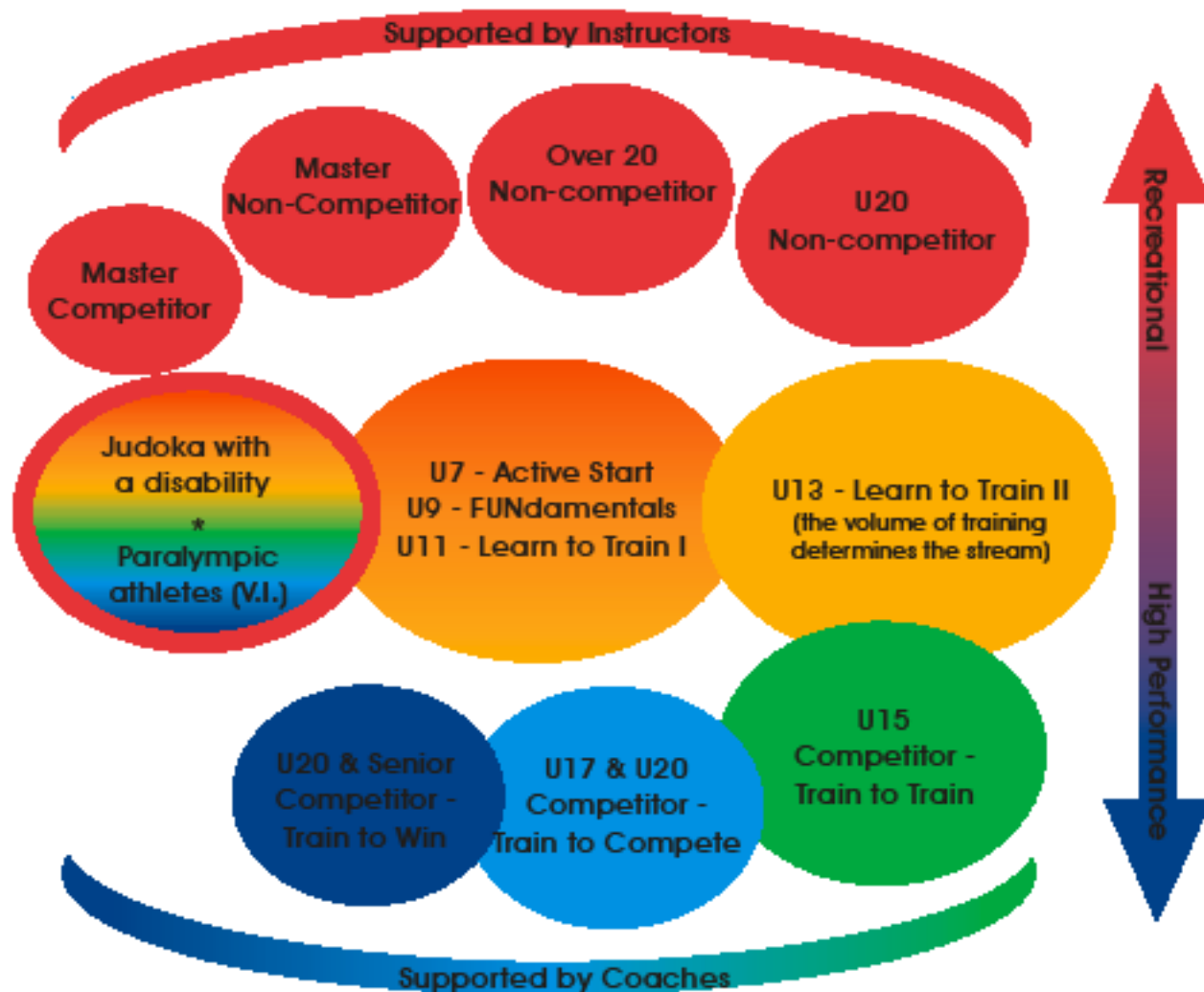

- The Long Term Athlete Development Model is a system to allow progression of sport based activities from very young to retirement.
- Competency based is to ensure our coaches are using the latest coaching techniques to ensure our athletes are having fun, are learning and giving them the best chance to STAY involved in sports.

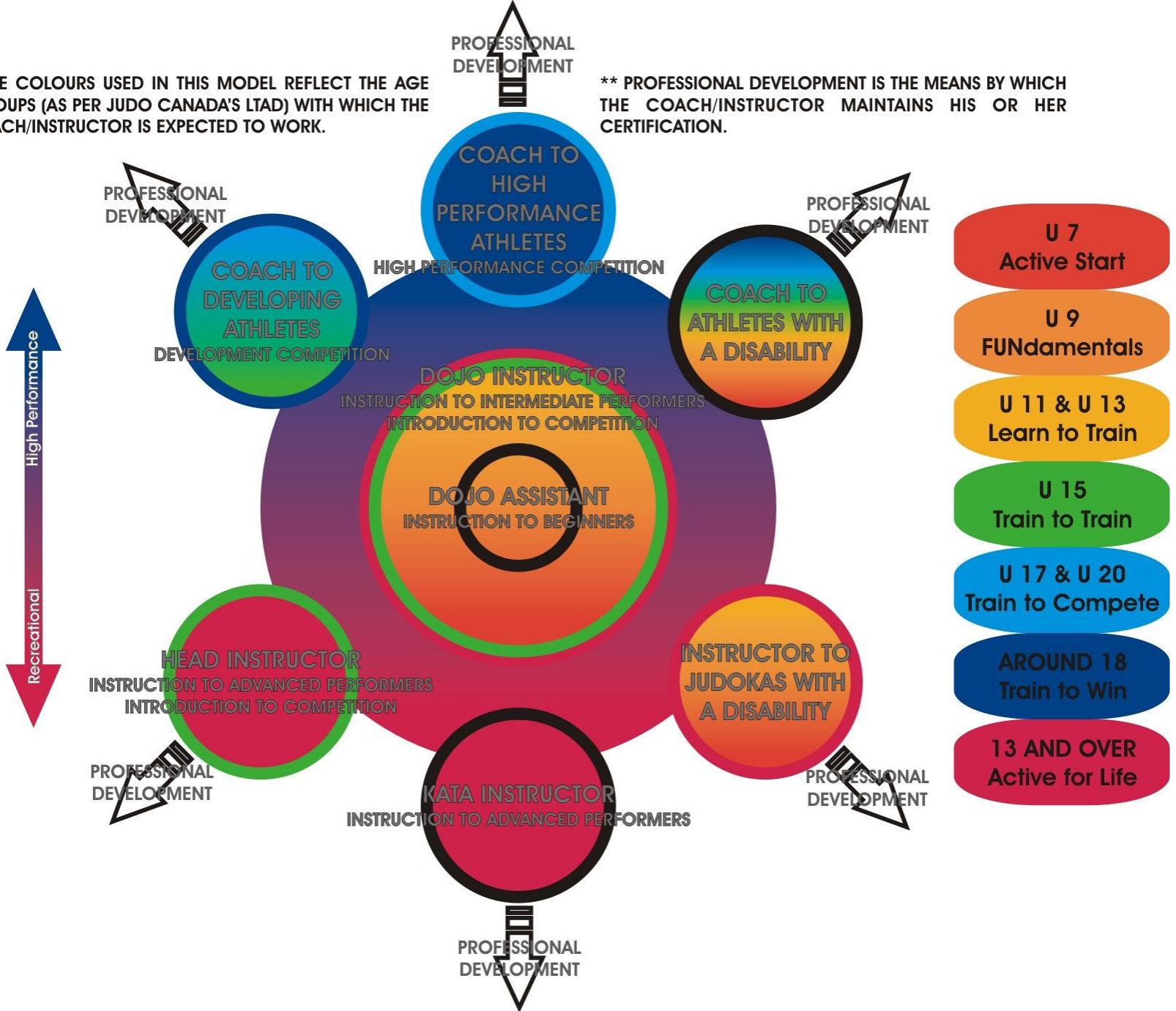
Taking it to the Mat

NCCP Context?

Two Streams - Coach and Instructor

Instructor – recreational athletes

- Instructor Beginner (DA)
- Instructor Intermediate (DI)

Coach – competitive or elite athletes

- Competitive Introduction (DI)
- Competitive Development (Level III)

What equivalency will be granted from
the old NCCP to the new NCCP?

Equivalency for Level I

Level I theory or technical ONLY = DA In Training

Level I theory & technical = DA Trained

Level I Certified plus MED online = DA Certified

Equivalency for Level II

Level II theory or technical ONLY = DI In Training

Level II theory & technical = DI Trained

Level II Certified plus MED online = DI Certified

Equivalency for Level III

Being worked on by Judo Canada and the Coaching Association of Canada currently.

What about foreign credentials being accepted?

- Bachelor degree in coaching – DA certified
- Master degree in coaching – DI certified
- PHD in coaching – Coach Comp Dev (old L3)

- For Level 3 equivalency, must be Level 2 certified.

Professional Development

PD points required in 5 years

Minimum Professional Development credits required

Context (includes any gradation) certification is valid for 5 years

Assistant  10 points

Instructor  20 points

Coach - Competition – Development  30 points

How do I get Professional Development points?

By attending approved activities and by
coaching!

But,
what are these courses?

Active coaching 1 point/year for every season coached, maximum 5 points

1 point/year for Learning Facilitator or Evaluator activity, maximum 5 points

NCCP activity 5 points/module, no maximum

Technical clinics and courses, sanctioned Nationally, 3 points for a minimum of 3 hours of an activity. No maximum or minimum

Coach self directed activity, 3 points for the valid certification period (i.e. St. John Ambulance), maximum 3 points

Re-evaluation in context, 100% of the points required for PD credit in the context with no other PD required if coach chooses re-evaluation

NCCP activity, 5 points/module, no maximum or minimum

Non-NCCP activity, 1 point/hour of activity up to 3 points maximum for a single activity. Maximum 50% of required PD points
