RE: 2017 Judo BC Fall Inter-Provincial Camp – Team BC Accommodation and Transportation Information & Hotel Booking deadline reminder

Date: August 16, 2017

The 2017 Fall Inter-Provincial Camp training camp is scheduled for September 29th to October 1st in Invermere BC. This camp is open to males and females U14, U16, U18, U21, senior and veteran (masters) athletes with a minimum rank of sankyu (green belt) for U16 and up and minimum rank of yonkyu (orange) for U14. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for all the camp details including accommodation information.

Club/families can arrange their own accommodation and transportation to Invermere, or Judo BC members can travel (pick up points Prince George, Burnaby, Abbotsford, Kamloops & Vancouver Island*) and stay with Team BC. If clubs/families arrange their own accommodation and transportation they are also responsible for supervision of their athletes both on and off the mats. If traveling and staying with Team BC, Judo BC will provide supervision.

If you are arranging your own travel and accommodation please note the booking deadline for the host hotel, the Copper Point Resort, is **August 30th.** After this date, the block of rooms being held will be released.

To register to travel and stay with Team BC please select the "travel with Team BC option" when registering <u>ONLINE</u>. The registration deadline if traveling with the Team is **August 29th** and everyone is required to register including coaches and all members of the Judo BC High Performance Elite and Development Teams. If you have already registered for the camp, please send an email to <u>info@judobc.ca</u> let us know if you want to travel and stay with the team or if you will be arranging your own transportation and accommodations.


Cost

The estimated cost to travel with Team is \$275/person. An invoice with the final costs will be sent to your club in September.

Camp fee:	\$75 (includes 1 lunch and 1 dinner)
Hotel:	\$80 (2 nights, 4 per room)
Bus transportation:	~ \$120 (round trip – final cost depends on the number of people)

- ~ 10:30 pm Bus 1 arrives in Burnaby

* Note: Judo BC will work with the Vancouver Island Regional Training Centre on the travel to Invermere. The Island participants may need to stay over in Metro Vancouver on Thursday, Sept 28th and/or Sunday, Oct 1st.
