JUDO BC CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEAM BC ATHLETES

The Athlete Code of Conduct applies to all athletes representing Judo BC, British Columbia or participating in Judo BC Team events. This code applies to athletes funded by Judo BC as well as self-funded athletes. As a condition to receive selection or sanction to represent Judo BC or BC at any tournament, training camp, or other event, athletes are unequivocally obligated by this code. Failure to sign the Athlete Code of Conduct by the required deadlines may result in you forfeiting your selection to the team.

In addition to those outlined in this code, The Judo BC Head Coach has the authority of Judo BC to establish a reasonable set of rules for all Judo BC Team athletes.

This code adopts and accepts all the language contained in the BC Universal Code of Conduct.

The Athlete Agrees:

- to treat other athletes, officials (on & off the mat), and coaches with respect.
- to refrain from comments, jokes or remarks relating to religion, gender, race or disability.
- to respect the rules as defined by the Head Coach, Assistant Coach(es), Team Manager, and Judo BC while at any event or activity as a member of a Judo BC team.
- to avoid excessive use of alcohol or providing alcohol to minors, if of BC legal drinking age.
- to abstain from the use of alcohol if under the BC legal drinking age.
- to respect the social rules of the host community or country.
- to wear appropriate, clean clothing and uniforms, as required.
- to refrain from taking performance enhancing substances (as defined by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport).
